PRAYER: DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET (ON ORDINARY ROSARY BEADS)

1. Sign of the Cross
2. The Our Father
3. The Hail Mary
4. The Apostles' Creed
5. On the Large Bead before Each Decade:

“Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.”

6. On the Ten Small Beads of Each Decade:

“For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.”

7. Concluding Doxology (At the conclusion, three times):

“Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One,
have mercy on us and on the whole world.”

- I. Pope Saint John Paul II: “The Heart is a battle ground between lust and love.”
 - A. Interior struggle for each individual
 - B. Global Struggle for All Hearts:
 1. Culture of Death
 2. Culture of Life
- II. Whole Christ (Head/Body) Conquering the Fallen World:
 - A. Priest: Obedient Sacrifice Conquers Disobedient Self Pride
 1. Power of the Cross: Lowly Lifted Up, Mighty Cast Down:
 - a. Conquers sin, death, and Satan
 - b. Frees those in bondage for sanctification in grace and the Holy Spirit
 2. Members of Christ's Body offer the world and themselves through, with, and in the Eucharistic Lord:
 - a. Re-creation/New Creation in the Final Age (End Time)
 - b. Preparing a New Heaven and a New Earth
 - c. Martyrdom: “White” or “Red”—“When he opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the Word of God and for the witness they had borne” (Rev. 6: 9).
 - B. Prophet: Truth—Now Personal and Powerful
 1. “I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life” (Jesus).
 2. “For the Word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and spirit, of joints and marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart” (Heb. 4: 12).
 3. “[F]rom His mouth issued a sharp two-edged sword” (Rev. 1: 16).
 4. The Gospel Truth:

- a. Converts and Forms Minds and Hearts of Disciples
 - b. Contradicts and Converts the Nations through Missionaries
 - C. King: Establishing the Kingdom of God
 - 1. Dispelling Darkness and Overcoming Temptation/Sin Interiorly:
 - a. Purgation/Illumination/Union
 - b. Prayer: Vocal/Meditative/Contemplative
 - 2. Dispelling Darkness and Overcoming Sin in the Culture
